Alabama will mark the 31st state where Kona Brewing Co.'s beers are available. Beginning the week of April 2nd, Kona beers and will be available in stores and on draught in such cities as Birmingham, Montgomery, Mobile, and Huntsville.

Kona Brewing's Longboard Island Lager will be available in bottles, on draught and in 12 ounce cans for better portability where glass bottles typically aren't allowed – like on Gulf Shores beaches or by the pool. In addition to Kona's other year-round offering Fire Rock Pale Ale, Kona's full seasonal line up of Aloha Series beers will also be available beginning with the spring seasonal in the series, Koko Brown.
